DRUG WARNING

1. The purchase, sale, possession, supply and/or use of drugs other than "over the counter" medications and those authorized by a Dentist or Medical Doctor is a breach of the Criminal Code of Canada. If a member of 337 Royal Canadian Army Cadet Corps is found to be involved in the purchase, sale, possession, supply and/or use of illegal drugs, the Corps will report the Member to the police, inform the Member's Parent/Guardian of this action and immediately dismiss the Member from the Corps with the comment "Released for Unsatisfactory Conduct" entered in their Cadet Record.
2. The use of intoxicating substances such as "airplane glue" and "cooking sprays" is harmful to your health and can be illegal. If a member of 337 Royal Canadian Army Cadet Corps is found to be involved in use of such intoxicating substances, the Corps will report the Member to the police, inform the Member's Parent/Guardian of this action and immediately dismiss the Member from the Corps with the comment "Released for Unsatisfactory Conduct" entered in their Cadet Record.
3. In Ontario, the purchase and/or use of alcoholic beverages by a person less than 19 years old is illegal. If a member of 337 Royal Canadian Army Cadet Corps is found to be involved in use of alcoholic beverages the Corps will report the Member to the Police, inform the Member's Parent/Guardian of this action and immediately dismiss the Member from the Corps with the comment "Released for unsatisfactory Conduct" entered in their Cadet Record.
4. The use of tobacco products has been found to be harmful to your health, the purchase of tobacco products by minors is illegal and it is a breach of Military Discipline for Cadets to smoke while in uniform or during Cadet activities. If a member of 337 Royal Canadian Army Cadet Corps is found to be using tobacco products while in uniform or during Cadet activities without parent/guardian and the Commanding Officer's permission, the Corps will inform the Member's Parents/Guardians and the Member subject to disciplinary action ranging from a warning to reduction in rank to dismissal from the Corps with the comment "Released for Unsatisfactory Conduct" entered in their Cadet Record.
