CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. I will respect the environment, my surroundings manmade and natural.
- I will be on time for all parades and training events, and will call to inform that I am unable to attend cadets prior to that event.
- 3. I will respect other people, their opinions, ethnicity, religion, performance and their belongings.
- 4. I will not touch any cadet unless absolutely necessary (i.e during an emergency or during training)
- 5. I will practice good principles of leadership, teamwork, and honesty; I will take responsibility for my actions, and I will also attempt to foster those qualities with my peers.
- 6. I will refrain from all alcoholic beverages, drugs (unless prescribed) and pornographic material; I recognize that Cadets is a smoke-free environment and I am not allowed to smoke.
- 7. I will not consume any over-the counter-medications of other substances that may alter my behaviour.
- 8. I will maintain and use National Defence, Government belongings properly. I will not sell them, give them away and I will work hard at not losing any equipment or clothing as issued.
- 9. I agree not to commit theft or to borrow the belongings of others without having been authorized to do so by the owners of the belongings in question.
- 10. I will respect other person's personal space and expect them to respect mine.
- 11. I will speak to cadets and superiors in a professional manner, without yelling or using vulgar language.
- 12. I will do my best to demonstrate my leadership abilities and set a good standard of dress and deportment.
- 13. I will not discuss subject matters such as sexism, ethnicity, religion or other topics, which could be negative or inappropriate.
- 14. I will not use intimidation, treats or bullying with my peers and subordinates.
- 15. I agree to obey all the rules and regulations and report to an officer any breach of the rules which I may be aware.

My conduct will reflect cadet regulations; orders issued by the Commanding Officer and understand these rules apply when engaged in authorized cadet activities in or out of uniform. I also acknowledge that a breach of one or more of the aforementioned rules could result in administrative, disciplinary, or criminal measures including release from the cadet program.
